Struggle of Kerala Gramin Bank Employees

We like to draw your attention to the fact that employees and officers under Kerala Gramin Bank Employees Union and Kerala Gramin Bank Officers Union, affiliated to Bank Employees Federation of India-Kerala (BEFI-K) are on agitation for the past 6 months on a just demand for **recruitment to the post of Office Attendants and regularisation of daily waged employees**

Even though they have put this demand to the notice of the management through several communications, protest demonstrations and agitational programs including strike and sit-in demonstration before Head Office, it is learnt that the management has not moved even a single step to discuss or settle the issues.

Now the next stage of the agitation is going on with two of the leaders, the General Secretary of Officers Union Sri. Prakasan and Convenor of the women committee Smt. Rajithamole is on indefinite hunger strike from December 11 onwards which is to be continued along with indefinite strike by the Employees and Officers from December 17 onwards.

Protest demonstrations and dharnas have taken place at the Head Offices of other RRBs all over India demanding settlement of the issues in Kerala Gramin Bank. The agitation is gathering notice and support from all sections of the public in Kerala in a quick pace.


We feel that there has been deterioration of industrial relations in Kerala Gramin Bank due to obduracy of the management of the said bank to settle the matter.
